

## **RESULTS DAY (A2 students)**

You can collect your results on Thursday 13<sup>th</sup> August 2020 between the hours of 9:00am – 11:00am.

It is really important that you attend the school to collect your results – just in case you need to speak to universities.

Once you've checked the UCAS track and opened your results, there are a few things that could happen.

### **1. You've made your firm offer! Congratulations!**

Check that your results meet the exact terms of your offer. Do this very carefully! Other than that, you do not need to do anything apart from check UCAS track. This should now show your status as 'final place accepted' but may take a while to update. If it hasn't updated by Monday, contact Ms S James at [james.s@rgtrustschool.net](mailto:james.s@rgtrustschool.net) and phone the university to check that everything is okay.

### **2. You've missed your firm offer First of all check UCAS Track**

- A) Your firm offer may still accept you with your missed grades. Congratulations!
- B) If Track still shows your status as 'final place accepted' you'll need to phone the university.
- C) If Track says 'eligible for clearing' – they won't accept you on dropped grades

### **3. You miss your firm offer but meet the requirements of the insurance offer**

You don't need to do anything further now apart from check UCAS Track. Again, this may take a while to update on UCAS Track. You may like to phone your insurance university to clarify that you're going there. You need to change your student loan using the (CO1) form.

### **4. Clearing**

This will be an option if you have been unsuccessful in gaining a place with either your firm or insurance choices. Because you will deal directly with university admissions staff in Clearing, UCAS advises that you should treat the process as a mini interview. Nothing can be gained from a speculative phone call with little or no understanding of the course or university, particularly during Clearing – it is still a competitive process and should be viewed as such. ## 5. Adjustment

If your exam results turn out to be better than expected and not only meet, but exceed, the conditions of your conditional firm offer, you have the option to use 'Adjustment' – a scheme that allows you to register and apply for other aspirational courses in a five-day window whilst holding on to a confirmed place. ### **If you are unable to collect results in person you must do the following:**

- Email [sixthform@rgtrustschool.net](mailto:sixthform@rgtrustschool.net) before Wednesday 12<sup>th</sup> August to formally request your results to be emailed to you.
- Have access to the internet so you can check UCAS Track
- Be prepared to go through the clearing process on your own (if necessary)

### **On results day bring all of the following with you:**

- Mobile phone (charged and topped up)
- UCAS track details/letters from UCAS and all letters from universities
- Contact details for your firm and insurance universities (admission tutors)


